All-Armenian Student Association (All-ASA) is a 501(c)3 organization that is comprised of student organizations and groups in the community and at various of colleges and universities. The All-ASA First Annual Scholarship has 2 scholarships: one for high school students and one for current college students.

For High School Students:

Scholarship Amount: \$500

Requirements:

- Must be going to an accredited high school in the United States (show proof of class schedule and student ID)
- Must be active in an Armenian activity, organization, or foundation
- Must have at least a 3.5 GPA (show proof of report card)
- Must have the intention of proof to college acceptance for the following year (if Senior)
- Must submit a typed double spaced essay of at least 500 words but no more than 750 words on how you plan on giving back to the Armenian Community
- Recommendation letter from at least 1 teacher or Armenian Organization

For Current College Students:

Scholarship Amount: \$750

Requirements:

- Must be active in an Armenian activity, organization, or foundation
- Must be registered student at an accredited college in the United States (show proof of class schedule and student ID)
- Must have at least a 3.0 GPA
- Must submit a typed double spaced essay of at least 500 words but no more than 750 words on how you plan on giving back to the Armenian Community
- Recommendation letter from at least 1 professor or Armenian Organization
